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# THE YEAR 2017 CONFERENCE: VENUE AND ELECTION OF CHAIRPERSON AND VICE-CHAIRPERSON

# Introduction

- 1. The 7<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Pacific Community agreed that all future meetings of the Conference of the Pacific Community will be convened at SPC headquarters in Noumea, New Caledonia as a cost-saving measure.
- 2. Notwithstanding this, member countries wishing to host the meetings of the Conference and the associated pre-conference meeting of CRGA may do so on the basis that they meet the full additional cost of convening the meetings of Conference and CRGA outside of SPC headquarters.
- **3.** In this regard unless a member expressly wishes to host the next meeting of the Conference of the Pacific Community, the 10<sup>h</sup> Conference of the Pacific Community in 2017 will be held at SPC headquarters in Noumea, New Caledonia.

### Elections of Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson

- 4. The current 'Rules of Procedure for the Conference' state:
  - *i. "When the conference is to be held at the headquarters of the Pacific Community, the conference shall elect the government or administration to provide the Chairperson for the succeeding conference. Such a government or administration shall normally be one that will not be in a position to act as host to the conference in the foreseeable future.*
  - *ii.* When the conference is to be held elsewhere than the headquarters, the host country/territory shall nominate the chairperson.
  - iii. Each conference shall elect the government or administration that will provide the vicechairperson for the succeeding conference. Such a government or administration shall normally be one that is chosen in alphabetical order of members from among the Pacific Island countries and territories."
- 5. For the information of Conference the hosting, chairing and vice-chairing arrangements for conference meetings since 1997 have been as follows:
